## **MANDELIN** REAGENT **IDENTIFICATION**

**Substance Test** 



Read **Before** Use

As a precaution, gloves and eye protection should be worn when handling drug substances and using test units. Do not puncture any part of unit. Do not remove probe once a capsule is broken. In the unlikely event of a spill, rinse affected area thoroughly with water. Keep out of reach of children. All results are presumptive. If necessary, further testing by a competent drug testing lab can provide additional identification.

## Powder

**Tablet** 

Touch Smart-Tip<sup>TM</sup> probe to sample.



Firmly press Smart-Tip<sup>TM</sup> probe on the tablet while scrubbing in a circular motion until the tip is completely covered with substance.



Do not continue unless probe is locked below the Flex Pins

Identification

forefinger, squeeze chamber 1 until capsule breaks.

Gently shake test unit for 2-3 seconds.



Results



The appearance of a green color indicates the presence of Methamphetamine or an opiate such as Heroin, Morphine or Codeine.



The appearance of a blue color indicates the presence of Methadone.



If neither color develops, the above drugs are not present.



Proceed to Dilution (steps 6-9), regardless of whether or not a color appeared.




Dilution



Gently shake test unit for 2-3 seconds.



Wait 5 minutes. The test window will warm up. This is normal.





Gently shake test unit for 2-3 seconds.



The test window will warm up. This is normal.



Disposal

After Dilution, the test kit is safe to dispose of in the trash.
