

Acetone Test Kits

Read **Before** Use

As a precaution, gloves and eye protection should be worn when handling substances and using test units. Do not practure any part of unit. Do not remove probe after breaking the ampule. In event of a spill, rinse affected area thoroughly with water. Keep out of reach of children. Store the tubes in a dark place, not exposed to light. All results are presumptive.

Test Preperation

Remove the SWIPPERTM Cap from the test unit.



Ensure that the test tube remains upright in order to avoid the ampule falling out of the tube.

Insert the pipette in the liquid and fill to the red line, then squeeze into the test unit.





Test Preperation

Return the SWIPPERTM Cap to the test tube. Press firmly.



STOP

Do not continue unless the SWIPPERTM Cap and the green O-Ring are properly secured.

dentifcation

With thumb and forefinger, squeeze the test tube until the ampule breaks.



Gently shake test up and down to ensure that the liquid touches the Cap.



Results



The appearance of a green color indicates the presence of Acetone.



If a green color does not develop, Acetone is <u>not</u> present.



The test kit is safe to dispose of in the trash.
